TO: Property Owners in El Paso County

Survey activities are underway for the El Paso County Risk Mapping, Assessment and Planning (Risk MAP). The Risk MAP study was initiated to update flood risk information and floodplain mapping in certain watersheds of El Paso County based on new information available. The study will help develop data that reflects actual, updated conditions and provide a framework for land use and other decision-making in areas likely to be affected by future flooding, erosion, debris flow, or related hazard events.

The Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) is the lead agency coordinating these updates. The mapping and survey contractors working with the CWCB are from AECOM, who is a well-qualified, nationally recognized engineering firm with expertise in floodplain mapping and field surveying. They will be conducting field surveys and remote sensed measurements of structures in and near the flood-prone areas in your community. The State has been in contact with your county and municipal officials to inform them of this project and to obtain their input regarding past flooding risks in your area.

While performing the field survey, survey crews will make every effort to stay on public lands and right of ways. It may be necessary, however, for the surveyors to enter your property for short periods of time to obtain survey information in and near streams included in the study. The survey crews will only be collecting elevation data and other ancillary information (e.g. photographs of the land), will respect your property, and will not interfere with your use of it while conducting the surveys.

We kindly request your assistance in providing us with a good phone number to contact you at so that the project team can reach out ahead of the survey to notify you when the crew will be accessing your property. 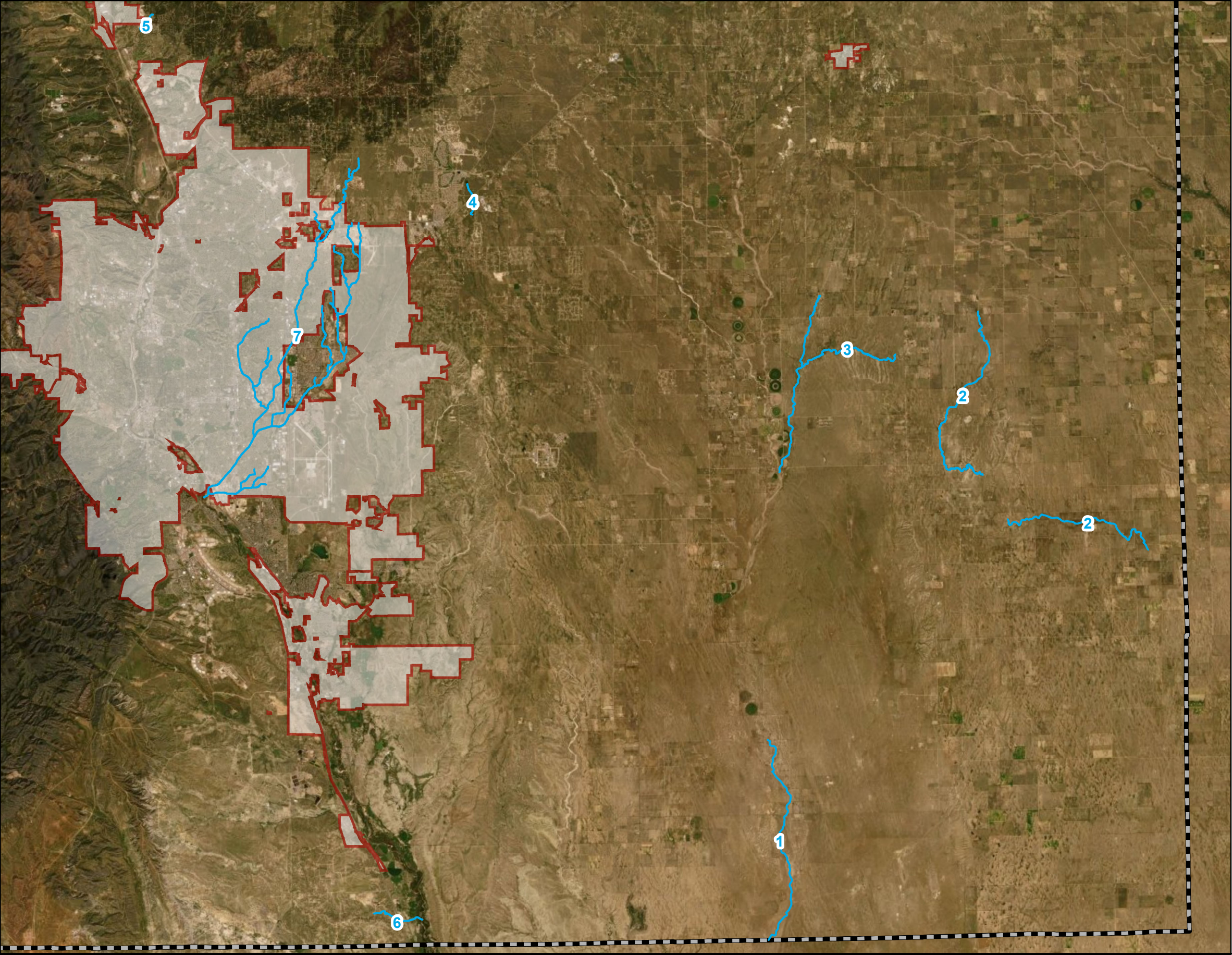

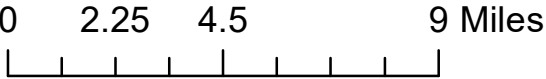
